Registering and Participating

- **Registrants:** Nursing Homes sign up but don't consistently enter data
- **Participants:** Nursing Homes demonstrate commitment to principles of performance improvement by entering data

- **To be considered a participant:**

Data should be uploaded onto the website monthly for 6 consecutive months.

For the 2nd selected goal, monthly data entry is optional in the first year but must be entered by the second year.

- Nursing Homes registered for the campaign must choose at least 2 goals (had been 3 in the past) – One process goal (consistent assignments, staff stability, reducing hospitalizations or person-centered care) and one clinical goal (pain, mobility, pressure ulcers, medications or infections).
- Nursing Homes may change their goal selection at any time until May 1, 2013. At that time, the Advancing Excellence Campaign will lock the goal selections until the next open selection period.
